Thinlinc Terminals / System general

- IT Questions & problems?

 - Come to office Y27/ K30 or make a call.
- Central 'homes' server.
 - o Backup: every night and the last 4 hours in 15 minutes intervals.
 - Your Backup is available under: ~/.zfs/snapshot ('~' means your home directory)

Desktop Session: Ubuntu (Gnome/Mate)

- Terminals
 - Never log-out to interrupt work, press: 🕫 > Disconnect
 - o Switching a terminal on/off don't affect your session.
 - o By log in on a second terminal, the session will be moved from the first terminal.
 - Activate screen-lock by pressing Ctr-ALT-L
 - USB Sticks connected to a Terminal (behind the screen) will automatically be mounted under ~/thindrives. If not:
 - Start 'Applications > System Tools > Clean USB Stick Umount/Mount'
 - or try a windows station on the floor | (Room | 11) or K (Room K49).
 - o **Trouble** with your session? Quit the session.
 - Before log in, mark the check-box 'End Existing Session'
- Applications:
 - o please check the 'Applications' menu.
 - Non 'Ubuntu' packages are listed under: www.math.uzh.ch/sepp
 - o don't hesitate to contact the IT group, if you need further applications to be installed.
- The servers are rebooted about once every 4-12 weeks (during the night). After a reboot, you have to log-in again.
- If a server fails (crash, ...) your session and any unsaved data are lost.
- Email: use the standalone email application **Thunderbird** or the **Zimbra web-interface.**
- Alt-Tab: switching between the applications on the current workspace.
- Quick Start: Alt-F2 command line / terminal, a.e. firefox, xterm, xpdf, ...
- Workspaces



- Number, size & name are configurable.
- o Switch workspace: Ctrl-Alt-LEFT | RIGHT
- o Application windows can be moved between workspaces.
- Create a bookmark in the file manager, f.e. for /scratch/scan .
- Tomboy Notes = small yellow slips
- Typing umlauts (ö,ä,ü): compose + vowel + accent (release each key after pressing)
- Mendeley: free reference manager and academic social network
- The panels can be moved, changed, customized. You can also add applets: right click, choose "Add to panel..."
- Trouble with Firefox, Thunderbird, Skype, Gnome or USB Sticks?
 Please check 'Applications > System Tools > Clean ...'
- **Tech-news**: Applet in the upper right corner & Local Info
- **Dropbox**: 'Applications > Internet > Dropbox'.
- Drive (nextCould): 'Applications > Internet > Drive(nextCould,OwnCloud)'.
- **Screenshot**: 'Applications > Graphics > Flameshot', or key 'prt sc'.
- Clipboard: in upper right corner, last 20 entries.

Computations

- **Small** and **short**: start locally in your terminal session.
- **Big** or **long**: contact the IT support first there are different compute servers available.

Windows

- There are several Windows PC: three are accessible in H52, J11 and K49 (scanning, CD/DVD burning, ...), or accessible via your terminal.
- Log-in with your regular user-name/password for the institute.
- Your files are available under 'My Documents'.
- Change language under Start > Control Panel > Regional and Language options
- You can access Windows also from a Terminal by: Applications > Remote Desktop > Windows 2016 (opens a Remote desktop Session on our Windows Server 2016 with Office 2016)
- Default printer under Windows: 'k49'

Scanning

- G25: Printer/Copy Machine
- H52: Scanner on the Windows PC.
- Floor J: Color Scan (Copy Machine)
- Floor K: Color Scan (Copy Machine)



Fax

• Fax devices are in the secretary offices J14 and K16

Mail

- Server: IMAP/POP=mail.math.uzh.ch SMTP= mail.math.uzh.ch
- **Calendar**: organize your dates in the Zimbra Calendar (multiple calendars are possible) and synchronize them with your mobile phone by CalDav protocol.
- **Contacts**: Import business contacts in your Zimbra address book. For members of the institute: on each personal page there is a QR Contact code. Just take your mobile phone, open a QR app, and import such an address in your phone.

Phishing Mails

- New phishing mails are posted on the intranet. Please refer to them if you want to check a suspicious email. If the suspicious email isn't listed there, please forward such a mail to support@math.uzh.ch.
 - If you provide your credentials on a malicious website, often just a few minutes later it will be misused to send spam. As a consequence the institute will be automatically black listed by the ZI mail server and no one of the institute can send mails anymore. Please be careful.
- We're monitoring the amount of sent mails and in case of misuse we will lock a hacked email account.

Printing

- Printers are named according to the office number: The name of the printer in room Y27H52 is 'h52'.
- All public printers are duplex printers and will print duplex by default which can be turned off.
- The Printer 'pdf' is a virtual printer, that creates a PDF file out of a print job. This file is stored under ~/output.pdf. Warning: an existing output.pdf will be overwritten without asking!
- Cancel print jobs
 - o On the upper right corner you will a printer symbol as long as a print job is active.
 - Click on the icon to open the print queue, select the job and choose CANCEL.
- You can change the default printer under "System -> Administration -> Printing", right click on a printer, choose "Set as Default".
- Color printing is expensive: Assistants have a print quota of 1000 credits per semester on colored pages. If a print job is not accepted, you'll be informed by email. If you need more print credits, please contact IT support.
- Paper empty: help yourself paper should be located in the metal cabinets on floor J & K next to the printer.
- Toner empty: contact IT support.



Firefox

- Open a link in a new tab by pressing the middle mouse button (scroll wheel).
- Copying rows or columns in a table: hold down CTRL.
- Custom keywords can be defined for search fields (right click into search field of the desired page, "add a keyword for this search...") >> use in browser address bar.
- Ctrl-k: changes cursor into the upper right search field
- Ctrl-I: changes cursor into the address bar

Homepage

- Each member of the institute is mentioned on the homepage (Name, Office, Tel, ...) = personal homepage.
- Each member of the institute can maintain an additional *private Homepage* (please ask IT for setup).
- Professors & assistants have sub-pages: events / research / vita (curriculum vitae).
 - o Events are assigned automatically.
 - o Entries in research and vita have to be created manually (by themselves) under 'Local Info'.
- The data of your homepage are maintained mainly by the people directly responsible. a.e.: The
 exercise trainer uploads the scripts concerning the lecture via the web interface to the
 homepage under 'Local Info'.
- All events (seminars, lectures, ...) are already on the homepage, so that you should only exceptionally create your own homepages for a lecture/seminar (**please consult the IT first**).

- Access to your data:
 - SSH: ssh.math.uzh.ch copy files, text applications
 - Linux: Places (caja) integrated, type **sftp://<user>@<host>:**

 - Mac: Filezilla http://filezilla-project.org
- Webmail: http://mail.math.uzh.ch

Private Notebooks

- In general there is **no** Support from the support group for private stuff but ask ...
- Internet
 - LAN: Plug in a cable and a network port with a yellow point.
 - The first time you have to register the notebook with your I-Math password.



■ For a cable ask the IT support.

Wikis

We have a number of Wikis for different topics / target groups: http://wiki.math.uzh.ch

We use Wikis for general guides and offer every work group their own wiki, which they can use freely. You are also welcome to update the public and institute wiki.

Public Wiki

The public wiki covers all the basic topics and is for general information that are important for students as well as the whole staff. You can access it without a log-in. For editing, you have to log-in with your IMATH Account.

Institute Wiki

Here are information that only can be accessed by employees of the math institute. You find information about our internal section of the website, shares and other services. For example how to handle exams, how to set up your personal homepage, etc.

You need to log-in with your IMATH account to view or edit this wiki. Students can't access the institute wiki.

Work-group Wiki

Every work group has their own Wiki and you have access to the wiki of the work group you are part of. To see the content, you have to log-in.

Git

Offers file version control and acts as a collaboration place: http://git.math.uzh.ch.



Create new private / work group or public projects via the web interface. It will show the first git commands individual adjusted to your project. Give it a try and be impressed how easy it is to use git and work with multiple persons on the same project & files. See also wiki.math.uzh.ch/public/Git.

/scratch/

'/scratch/' is a shared folder of the whole institute, with private subsections for work-groups, teaching and employees.

/scratch/scan/

The copiers will copy scans to this directory. The directory will be wiped out every night. The directory is accessible to every I-MATH user.

/scratch/tmp/<days>

If you have data which should not deleted now but perhaps in one week or in one year: move it to /scratch/tmp/7 or /scratch/tmp/365 – and forget it. The system automatically wipe's out directories which are older than <days>.

/scratch/share

Students do not have access to '/scratch/share'.

/scratch/share/<work-groups>

/scratch/share/seminare/<module number>/<semester>

/scratch/share/vorlesungen/<module number>/<semester> (veranstaltungen is a symlink)

Lending services

For lending books you must be registered as a library user. Please check the information desk and bring your UZH card with you. The lending period lasts 28 days. You can prolong it twice for further 28
